

STEP 1

Install the Step Pads onto the step bars with (32) M6X1-20 T-Bolts. (32) M6 Large Flat Washers and (32) M6 Nylon Lock

IMPORTANT: Don't hit the step pad by any metal hummer within step pad installation, or the step pad will be damaged.







Note: Rotate 90° after inserting the T-Bolts into the Channel!!!

STEP 2


(Fig 2) Passenger Side Front Mounting Location (The 2nd Pair of Factory Holes on Pinch Weld)

Starting installation from the passenger side of the vehicle, locate the (5) pairs of factory holes along the pinch weld. Move to the 2nd pair of holes directly under the center of the front door, (Figs 1 & 2). NOTE: There are (5) mounting locations along the inner body panel. Running Board installation will use the 2nd, 3rd and 5th mounting locations, (Fig 1).



(Fig 1) Passenger Side Mounting Locations (on The inner side of the Rocker Panel)



STEP 3


(Fig 3) Typical Mounting Location

Select (1) M10 Clip Nut. Insert Clip Nuts into the round hole beside the rectangular opening. **NOTE:** Threaded nut must go towards the inside of the side panel, **(Figs 3 & 4)**.

STEP 4


Assemble the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**DFM/PFM**) and Passenger Front Support Bracket (**DFS/PFS**) with (1) M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Flat Washers and (1) M8 Nylon Lock Nut, (**Fig 5**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



STEP 5

Attach the Assembled Passenger Front Bracket to the Clip Nut with the included (1) M10X1.5-30 Hex Bolt, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Flat Washer, (Fig 6). Attach the bottom hole in the Mounting Bracket to the (1) hole in the pinch weld with the included (1) M10X1.5-30 Hex Bolt, (2) M10 Flat Washers, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, (Fig 6). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

NOTE: Insert the Hex Bolt with Flat Washer through pinch weld first then through the Bracket from outside to inside.







STEP 6

Move to the Passenger Side Center Mounting location, (Fig 7). Repeat Steps 3 & 5 to install the Passenger Center Mounting Bracket, (Fig 8). Note: Passenger Center/Rear and Driver Center/ Rear Mounting Brackets are universal.

STEP 7

Move to the Passenger Side Rear Mounting Location. Repeat **Step 6** to install the Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket **onto** the Passenger Side Rear Mounting location at the back of the cab.

STEP 8

Once all (3) Brackets have been fully installed, attach the Assembled Passenger Side Step Bar onto the brackets with (4) M6X1-20 T-Bolts, (2) M6X1-20 Square Head Bolts, (6) M6 Large Flat Washers and (6) M6 Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Fig 9)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 9

Properly level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 10

Move to the Driver side of the vehicle. Repeat **Steps 2-9** for the Driver Side Step Bar installation.

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

In order to protect your bars/boards, please use only mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning.
