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


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
STEP 1




(Fig 1) Driver Side Mounting Bracket Locations

Starting installation from the driver side front of the vehicle. Locate and remove (1) rubber plug closest to the front tire opening, (Fig 1). Select (1) M10 Bolt Plate and (1) M10 Plastic Washer. Partially thread the M10 Plastic Washer onto the M10 Bolt Plate. Insert the M10 Bolt Plate into the opening and thread the M10 Plastic Washer down tight, (Fig 2).

NOTE: The M10 Plastic Washer is designed to hold the M10 Bolt Plate in place during Bracket installation.




STEP 2

Select the Driver Front Mounting Bracket (**DFM**). Attach the Bracket to the installed M10 Bolt Plate with (1) M10 Large Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, (**Fig 3 & 4**). Do not fully tighten the hardware at this time.



(Fig 3) Driver Front Mounting Bracket Installation



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

STEP 3

Move to the driver side rear mounting location of the vehicle, **(Fig 1)**. Locate and remove the (2) rubber plugs. Insert (2) M10 Bolt Plates into the openings with M10 Plastic Washers holding.




(Fig 5) Driver Rear Mounting Bracket Installation

Repeat **Step 2** to attach the Driver Rear Mounting Bracket **(DRM)** to the installed (2) M10 Bolt Plates, **(Fig 5)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 4

Once all (2) mounting brackets are installed. Select the Driver Side Running Board. Slip (2) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel (Fig 6). Carefully position the Running Board onto the (2) Mounting Brackets. Attach the Running Board to each Mounting Bracket with (2) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts, (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6 Nylon Lock Nuts (Fig 7). Do not fully tighten at this time.

IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Running Board on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged.



STEP 5

Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.

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





(Fig 8) Drill a 5/16" Hole Through Pinch Weld Do Not Drill Too Close To Edge Of Pinch Weld (Driver Side Rear Bracket Pictured)

Push the Mounting Brackets up tight against the bottom of the body. Use the mounting tab on each Bracket for a guide, mark and drill a 5/16" hole through the pinch weld for both Brackets, (Fig 8).

NOTE 1: Do not drill too close to the edge of the pinch weld, adjust Bracket position as required before drilling through pinch weld.


NOTE 2: It may be necessary to remove Running Board and Brackets to drill the required holes through the pinch weld. Repeat **Steps 2—4** to reinstall the brackets and Running Board.

IMPORTANT! Any cutting or drilling tool may break or shatter. Government regulations require safety glasses & equipment at all times when cutting or drilling.

STEP 6


(Fig 9) Attach Driver Front Mounting Bracket To Pinch Weld




(Fig 10) Attach Driver Rear Mounting Bracket To Pinch Weld

Once both holes have been drilled on the pinch weld, attach the mounting tabs on the (2) Driver Side Mounting Brackets to the pinch weld with (2) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolts, (4) M8 Flat Washers and (2) M8 Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figs 9 & 10). Fully tighten hardware at this time.




(2) M8 Flat Washers

STEP 7

Move to the passenger side front of the vehicle. Locate the rubber plug closest to the front tire opening, (Fig 11). Repeat Steps 1 & 2 to install the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (PFM), (Fig 12).

(Fig 12) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installation


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STEP 8




(Fig 13) Passenger Center Mounting Bracket Installation

Move to the Passenger side 2nd mounting location. Remove (2) rubber plugs, (Fig 11). Repeat Steps 1—3 to install the Passenger Center Mounting Bracket (PCM), (Fig 13).

STEP 9


(Fig 15) Passenger 3rd Mounting Bracket Installation

Move to the Passenger Side 3rd & Rear Mounting location, (Fig 14). Locate and remove the rubber plugs on the body panel. Select (2) Passenger Rear Mounting Brackets (PRM). Repeat Steps 1-2 to attach the Passenger Rear Mounting Brackets to the installed M10 Bolt Plate, (Fig 15).



(Fig 14) Passenger Side 3rd & Rear Mounting Location

STEP 10

Select the Passenger Side Running Board. Slip (4) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel (Fig 6). Repeat **Step 4** to attach the Running Board to (4) Mounting Brackets. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 11


(Fig 16) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Attached to the Pinch Weld

Repeat **Steps 4—6** to drill and attach the (4) Mounting Brackets to the pinch weld, **(Figs 16—18)**.

STEP 12

Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware. The installation is completed.

Attention
