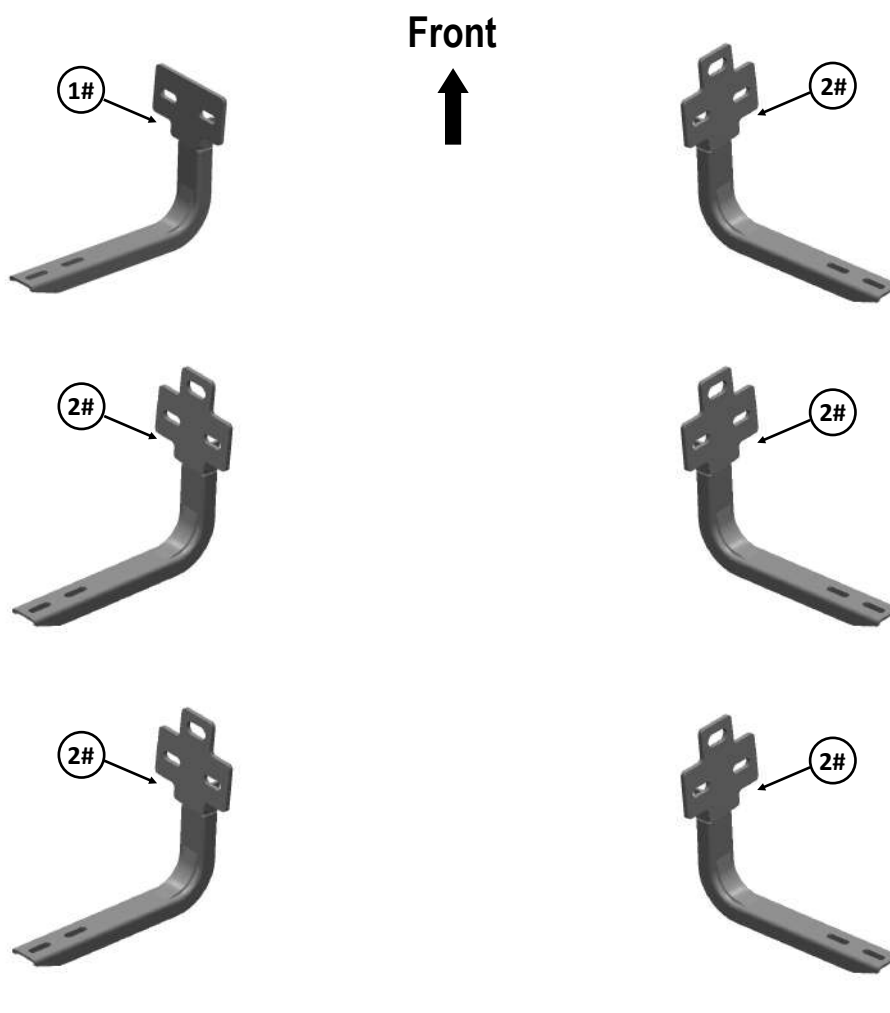

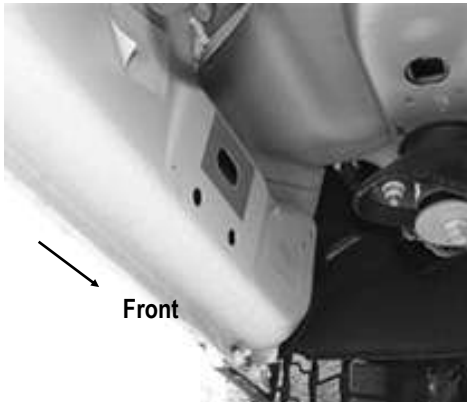

STEP 1

Starting at the driver side front of the vehicle, remove the sealing tape covering the factory holes in the side of the inner panel, (Fig 1).

STEP 2

Determine the correct procedure to attach (1) Driver Front Mounting Bracket for your model/year:

Models without factory threaded inserts in body panel:

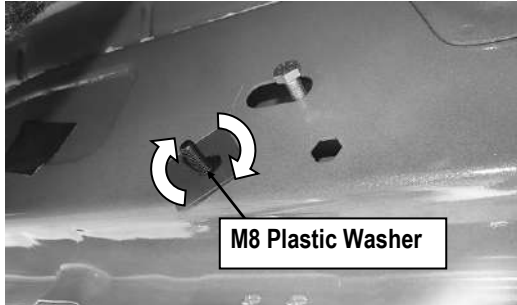


(Fig 3) Thread (1) M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolt into the welded nut on the plate.



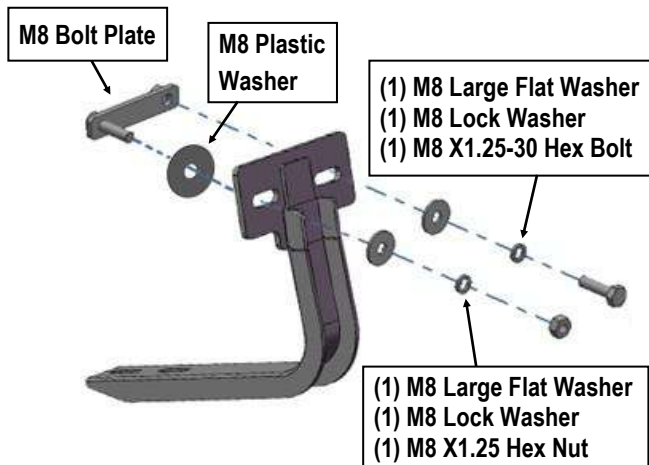
(Fig 4) Use the Hex Bolt as a handle. Insert the Bolt/Nut Plate into the oval hole and feed the threaded end out either factory hex shaped hole.

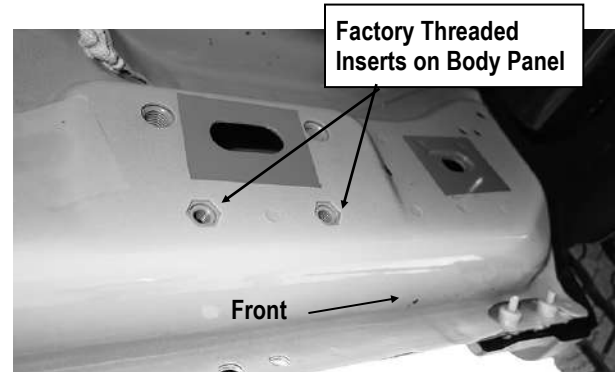
(Fig 5) Thread Plastic Washer onto Bolt Plate to hold Bolt Plate in position

- Partially thread (1) M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolt into the threaded end on (1) M8 Bolt/Nut Plate (Fig 2). Thread the hex bolt in until it is flush with the welded nut, (Fig 3). Use the hex bolt as a handle and insert the Bolt/Nut Plate into the oval hole, (Fig 4). Feed the threaded bolt on the plate through one of the hex holes. Thread (1) M8 Plastic Washer onto the threaded end and down tight against the body panel, (Fig 5).

NOTE: The Plastic washer is designed to keep the Bolt/Nut Plate from falling into the body panel and to aid in bracket installation.

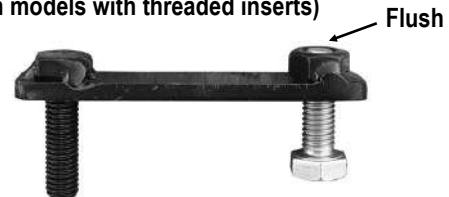
- Attach (1) Driver Front Mounting Bracket to the threaded end of the installed M8 Bolt/Nut Plate with (1) M8 Large Flat Washer, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8X1.25 Hex Nut, (Fig 6).

Remove the M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolt from the welded nut on the Bolt/Nut Plate. Rotate the Bolt/Nut Plate until the threaded nut lines up with the remaining hole in the Mounting Bracket and body panel. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

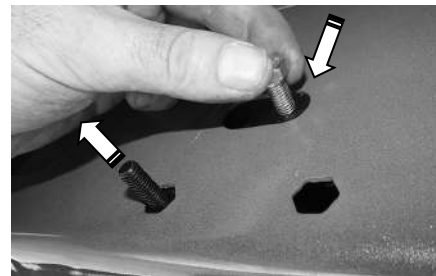
- Attach the Driver Front Mounting Bracket to the threaded nut on the M8 Bolt Plate with (1) M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolt, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Large Flat Washer, (Fig 6). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



(Fig 2) M8 Bolt/Nut Plate (NOTE: M8 Bolt/Nut Plate is not required on models with threaded inserts)

IMPORTANT: Do not remove the Hex Bolt until the Plastic Washer is threaded onto the welded bolt (Fig 5).

Models with factory threaded inserts:

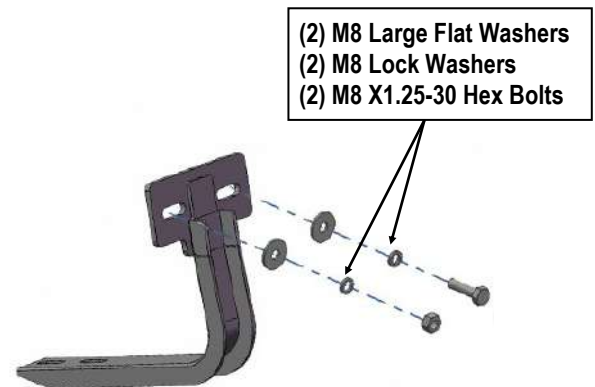

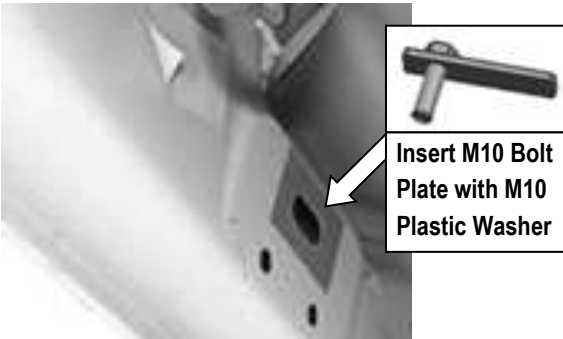


(Fig 8) Driver Front Mounting Bracket Installation

Attach Driver Front Mounting Bracket to the threaded inserts with (2) M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolts, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, (Fig 7 & 8). Leave hardware loose.

(Example of models with factory installed threaded inserts)

STEP 3

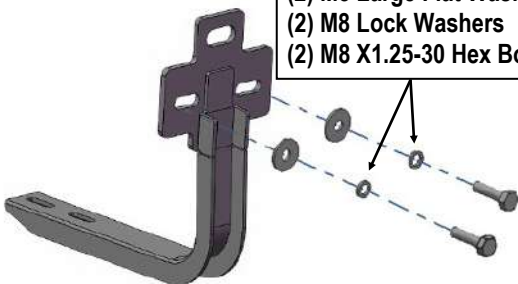
(Fig 9) Thread M10 Plastic Washer Onto M10 Bolt Plate to Hold M10 Bolt Plate In Place.

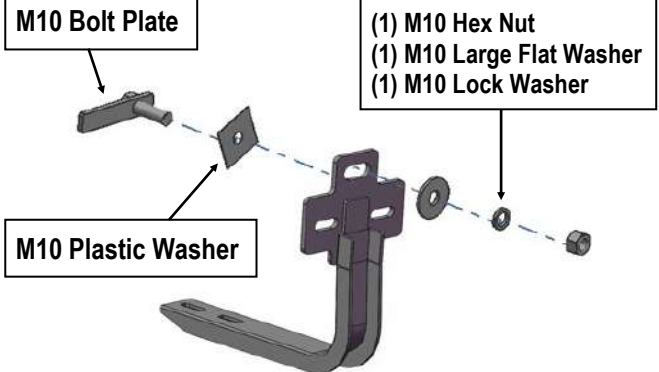


(Fig 10) Driver Center Mounting Bracket Installed to the Lower (2) Holes

Move along the side of the body panel to the Driver Side Center Mounting Location. Insert (1) M10 Bolt Plate into the upper oval slot (Fig 9). Repeat the **Step 2** to attach the Driver Center Mounting Bracket to the lower (2) holes (Fig 10 & 11). And then secure the bracket to the upper M10 Bolt Plate (Fig 12). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

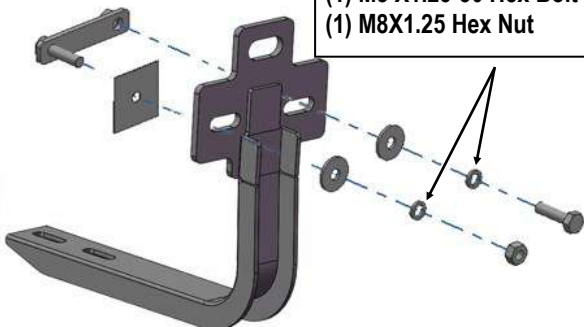
IMPORTANT: Other (5) Mounting Brackets are universal.



Insert M10 Bolt Plate with M10 Plastic Washer

Models without factory threaded inserts in body panel:
(2) M8 Large Flat Washers
(2) M8 Lock Washers
(1) M8 X1.25-30 Hex Bolt
(1) M8X1.25 Hex Nut

(2) M8 Large Flat Washers
(2) M8 Lock Washers
(2) M8 X1.25-30 Hex Bolts

STEP 4

Move to the Driver Side Rear Mounting Location. Repeat **Step 3** to install the Driver Rear Mounting Bracket.

STEP 5

Once all (3) mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Step Bar installation. According to the style of Step Bar proceed to the correct installation STEPS.

Note: Aluminum Step Bar refer to 6; Stainless Steel Step Bar skip to STEP 7.

STEP 6

Aluminum Step Bar Installation:

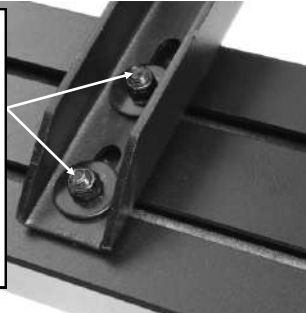


(Fig 13) Slip M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts Into The Bottom Channels

Select a **Aluminum Step Bar**. Slip (3) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel (**Fig 13**). Carefully position the Step Bar onto the (3) Mounting Brackets.

IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Step Bar on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged. Attach the Step Bar to each Mounting Brackets with (2) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts, (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 14**). Do not fully tighten at this time.

Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware.

Repeat **Steps 1-6** for the other side Step Bar installation. **The installation is completed!!!**

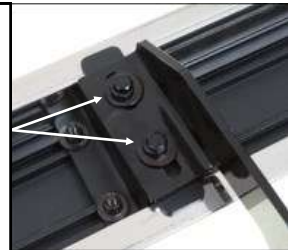
(Fig 15) Slide & line up the U-Slider with the installed mounting brackets along bottom channel

IMPORTANT: TORQUE FOR 6MM FASTNERS MUST LESS THAN 6-7 FT-LBS OR THE FASTNERS WILL BE DAMAGED!

STEP 7

Stainless Steel Step Bar Installation:

Select a **Stainless Steel Step Bar** (with the U-Sliders installed on the Bar). Loose the U-Sliders, reposition the U-Sliders onto the board according to the (3) Installed Mounting Brackets location, (Fig 15). Re-secure the U-Sliders on the Step Bar. Attach the Step Bar to the installed Mounting Brackets with (6) M6X1-20mm Hex Bolts, (6) M6 Large Flat Washers & (6) M6 Lock Washers, (Fig 16). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware.

Repeat **Steps 1-5 and 7** for the other side Step Bar installation.

The installation is completed!!!

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
In order to protect your bars/boards, please use mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning only.
